Collectors Resolution

This is to advise you that at a special meeting held on June 22, 1992, the Brookfield Board of Selectmen voted unanimously to adopt the above-referenced Resolutions, copies of which were sent to you on June 3, 1992.

Only one change was made to the Registration, Duties and Qualifications Resolution - that change being an addition of language in Section 1, Line 15 as follows:

"Each such collector shall upon request of the municipality disclose the name of any other municipality in which such collector hauls such solid waste or recyclables."

RESOLUTION

**BE IT RESOLVED:**

That, as authorized by the provisions of the Brookfield Recycling Ordinance, the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Brookfield hereby adopts the following rules and regulations concerning the collection of solid waste and recycling within the town:

**REGISTRATION, DUTIES AND QUALIFICATIONS  
OF SOLID WASTE COLLECTORS**

Sec. 1. In accordance with the provisions of subsection 22a-220a(d) of the Connecticut General Statutes, any collector hauling solid waste or recyclables generated by residential, business, commercial or other establishments in the Town of Brookfield shall register with the town on forms prescribed by the Director of Public Works. Upon registration and payment of an annual permit fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), each such collector shall be issued a permit to collect or continue the collection of solid waste or recyclables within the town. Each collector shall register on or before July 1, 1992 and shall receive a permit valid for the period beginning July 1, 1992 and ending June 30, 1993. Subsequent permits shall be for a period of one year commencing July 1st and ending June 30th. Permits issued hereunder shall not be transferred by the holder thereof. Each such collector shall\*disclose the name of any other municipality in which such collector hauls such solid waste or recyclables. The door of any private vehicle used to haul solid waste or recyclables shall be clearly marked with the business name and address of the collector. Each collector shall further be required to sign an affidavit of origin, under penalty of false statement, that all solid waste or recyclables disposed of in the name of the town or its residents shall originate from properties located within the corporate limits of the town or from such other locations as the town may permit.

Sec. 2. Each collector permitted to collect solid waste or recyclables within the town pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 1 hereof shall, subject to the further provisions hereof, collect or cause to be collected, all solid waste or recyclables generated by their Brookfield customers and required to be recycled pursuant to the requirements of the Brookfield Recycling Ordinance.

Sec. 3. No collector shall be required to provide collection services to any customer who is more than thirty (30) days delinquent in the payment of the collector's fee. If the delinquent customer shall discharge his delinquency, the collector shall immediately resume collection services to the customer.

Sec. 4. As conditions of the permits issued pursuant to this section, all collectors shall comply with the following requirements:

- (a) Collectors shall conform with all provisions of federal, state and local law.
- (b) Collectors shall keep accurate records of and report to the town or to any other entity designated by it the amounts, both in the aggregate and by category designated by the town hereof, of all recyclable materials collected by such collector within the town.
- (c) Collectors shall pay to the Housatonic Resources Recovery Authority or to the Intermediate Processing Center (IPC) operator or to any other entity designated by them the applicable tipping fees and charges with respect to those categories of recyclable materials accepted by and delivered to the IPC by such collector.
- (d) When delivering recyclable materials to an IPC, collectors shall use only equipment compatible with the efficient operation of the IPC, which equipment shall be subject to the reasonable approval of the operator thereof.
- (e) Collectors shall be responsible for all costs or damages relating to the delivery by it to the IPC of materials other than those recyclable materials which have been designated and approved by the town for delivery to the IPC.
- (f) Collectors shall provide to the Housatonic Resources Recovery Authority and to the IPC operator or owner a suitable performance bond or letter of credit to insure the performance of the collector's obligations hereunder. Said security shall be in such forms and amounts as determined by the town.
- (g) Collectors shall provide insurance covering their recycling operation, which coverage shall include the town, the Housatonic Resources Recovery Authority and the IPC owner and its operator as additional insureds. Such coverage shall include, but not be limited to, general liability, automotive liability, excess liability, workers' compensation and employer's liability in amounts reasonably deemed adequate by the town.


(h) Collectors shall only deliver solid waste and recyclables generated within the Town of Brookfield to facilities and locations which have been designated by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Brookfield pursuant to the provisions of Public Act 90-220 of the State of Connecticut.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
